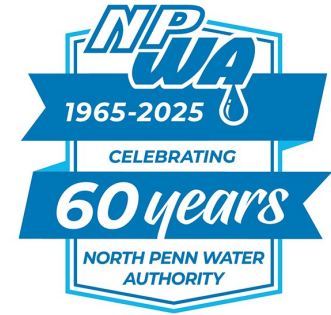

Construction Notice

Project: Main Street/Cowpath Road Service Line Renewals

North Penn Water Authority (NPWA) will begin the renewal of water services on North Main Street, Hatfield Borough and Township from School Lane to Bergey Road.

Presently, NPWA has approximately 37 services that are connected to an older 6" cast iron line prone to breakage. These services will be renewed to our newer 16" ductile iron main. Included with these renewals, we will be renewing several fire hydrants and tie-ins to the cross streets.

Project Summary:

This project involves the renewal of 37 water services with copper on North Main Street. The water services will be renewed from the existing water main to the property owner's curb stop located in the utility right of way behind the curb in the grass or sidewalk followed by soil, concrete and trench restoration.

We anticipate the construction work to take approximately 7 to 9 weeks to complete, weather permitting. This work is being done in cooperation with Hatfield Borough and Hatfield Township's joint paving program

Timeline:

The week of April 14, 2025 - Mobilization and construction will begin.

Customer Impact:

In order to ensure the public and workers' safety, North Main Street will be closed to through traffic during the hours of work (**7:00 am – 3:30 pm**).

At the end of each workday, the roadway will be open and traversable.

School buses, emergency vehicles and residents will have access to their homes, but may experience minor delays in some instances.

We will make every effort to keep unobstructed access open to local residents to the fullest extent possible.

We have notified your local emergency response units to assure they will have access and that your essential services are not interrupted.

For your protection, we have documented the property frontage of your curbs, sidewalks, blacktop, lawns and driveways to ensure that any damage that may be caused is restored to a condition that is at least equal to the current condition. All concrete, blacktop, or grassy areas that are dug up will be restored.

Our Commitment: We regret any inconvenience that you may experience during this period. This improvement project is part of our ongoing, asset management plan to replace older water mains in order to continue to provide our customers with high quality drinking water and adequate fire protection.
